Kodak Challenge 2008 Facts & Figures (*Had It Been Played*)

If the Kodak Challenge had taken place during the 2008 season, there would have been an exciting finish with **Patrick Sheehan** winning by one stroke over **Jason Gore**. Sheehan, ranked 128 in the final 2008 PGA TOUR Money List, tallied **17 under par** – his low score relative to par on 18 Kodak Challenge holes.
